IDT Requests will be processed in accordance with school board policy and administrative regulations (BP/AR 5117). Requests received on or before May 5, 2024, will be considered by the Board of Trustees at the regular meeting held in June, 2024.

IDT requests from non-resident students received after May 5, 2024 will be processed and considered at a subsequent Board meeting.

As provided by Education Code section 46600.2(a)(5)(B), notice of the Governing Board's decision on IDT requests for the 2023-24 school year will be given as soon as possible, but no later than 14 calendar days after the commencement of instruction.
