TRANSPORTATION FOR STUDENTS IN SPECIAL EDUCATION

Transportation for students with disabilities shall be provided in accordance with a student's Individualized Education Program (IEP).

The District shall provide transportation at no cost to the student or parent/guardian provided that transportation is specified in the student's IEP. (Ed Code 48915.5)

When the district is unable to provide the necessary transportation services for a student, it may enter into an agreement with the parent(s) to provide services in lieu of transportation. Parents who agree to provide in lieu services for their child will be reimbursed for their mileage at the rate established by the IRS. Mileage reimbursement shall be solely for transportation of the student to school for the start of school and return home at the end of the school day.
(Marin County Special Education Local Plan, Approved, OSC, February 12, 2010)

IEP teams shall authorize appropriate home to school/school to home transportation for students who are assigned to a school other than their neighborhood school for the purpose of receiving special education.
