Dear Nicasio School Families,

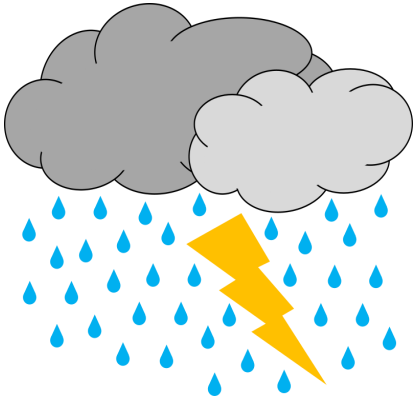
