- ▶ Riders will be picked up at the curb of their home or other location and dropped off at desired destinations within the service area
- ▶ First time riders must complete a brief registration process
- ▶ Rides must be pre-scheduled between 1 and 7 days in advance
- ▶ Return trips must also be pre-scheduled
