**1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded:**

Nicasio School District provides a weekly Movement Program, organized and directed by Professional Expert, Casey Lee Thorne. Our student body is comprised of 35 students in Kindergarten through 8th grade, 58% of whom qualify for free/reduced-priced meals and 27% are designated as English Learners. As a small, rural school many of our students lack access to high quality enrichment programs outside of the school day. As such, our mission is to provide specialist programs that expose our students to a variety of experiences in the areas of visual and performing arts as well as music. NDS's Movement Program aligns with this goal by providing rich instruction of choreographed dances from different cultures, including Bollywood, Musical Theater/Jazz, Hip Hop, West African dances, as well as popular American dance styles. These weekly classes provide opportunities for students to engage their bodies as well as their minds in a way that is developmentally appropriate, exciting and fun.
